Dear Conservative MPs,

The ongoing cost of living crisis and current heat wave have highlighted the acute risks if the UK Government does not proactively deliver a strategic approach to net zero. If the Climate Change Act and your party's manifesto commitments are not delivered, future crises will surely follow.

As the [Professional Bodies Climate Action Charter](#), we represent 13 million professional members globally across a wide range of sectors from science and engineering, law, health, construction and the built environment, and finance and insurance. Our members are deeply concerned that this government remains committed to delivering on the UK's net-zero and adaptation targets.

We have already witnessed the significant benefits of investing in the net zero transition. For example, the low-carbon renewables sector has grown in value to over [£200 bn, employing over 1.2 million](#) people. This has been supported by government initiatives such as the Net Zero Strategy and the UK's Ten Point Plan for a Green Industrial Revolution. Delivering the Net Zero Strategy could create another [440,000 well-paying jobs and unlock £90 billion in private investment by 2030](#).

This will not happen without continued government commitment to delivery. Professionals need a stable policy framework, guidance and training to align their sectors with net zero and reap the opportunities granted by the global transition. This will be reliant on a wider economic transition to net zero, across a range of sectors, supported by a suite of policies, including strategic public investment and clear market signals from a coherent direction of travel.

As the Conservative Party prepares to welcome a new Prime Minister to lead the UK, it is important that MPs prioritise net zero in order to meet the ambition and demand of the private sector. Implementing a robust Net Zero Strategy is the UK's best path to unlocking the numerous economic opportunities associated with the net zero transition, including shielding UK citizens from the ongoing energy price crisis, creating hundreds of thousands of high-quality jobs and unlocking private investment at scale for the sustainable markets of tomorrow.

We urge you to seize this opportunity to champion net zero, deliver energy security and maintain the UK's international status as a green leader.
